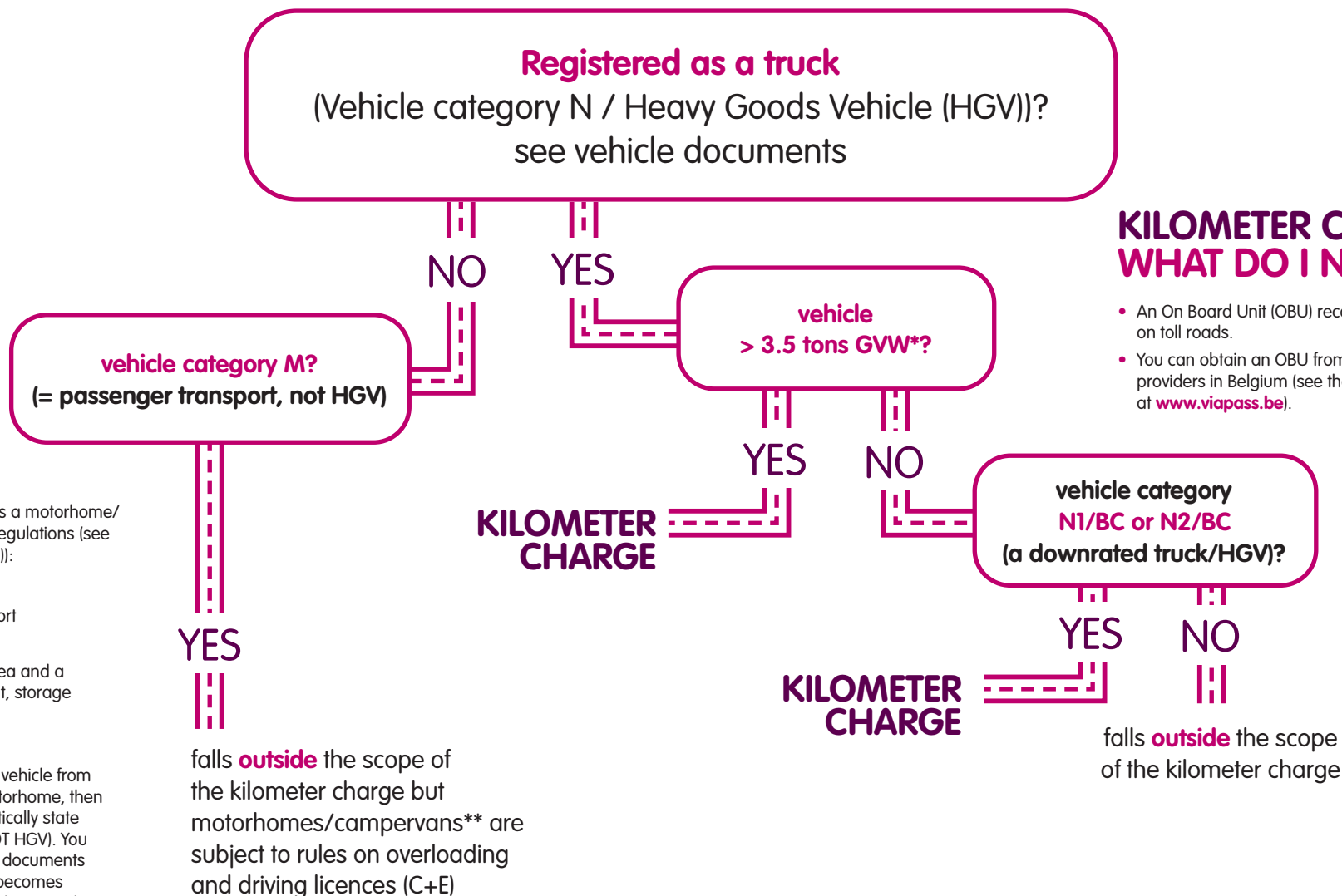


DO I HAVE TO PAY THE KILOMETER CHARGE FOR MY MOTORHOME/CAMPERVAN**?



KILOMETER CHARGE WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

- An On Board Unit (OBU) records the kilometers driven on toll roads.
- You can obtain an OBU from one of the accredited service providers in Belgium (see the "practical info" section at www.viapass.be).

** Conditions for qualifying as a motorhome/ campervan in the technical regulations (see certificate of conformity (COC)):

- at least four wheels
- built for passenger transport
- maximum 8 passengers
- living area with seating area and a (folding) table, cooking unit, storage facilities, sleeping area
- fixed to bodywork

Attention: if you convert your vehicle from category N / a HGV) to a motorhome, then the vehicle does not automatically state the vehicle category M (= NOT HGV). You first need to have the vehicle documents modified so that the vehicle becomes category M and therefore no longer subject to the kilometer charge.

*GVW = gross vehicle weight, see registration certificate box J
