

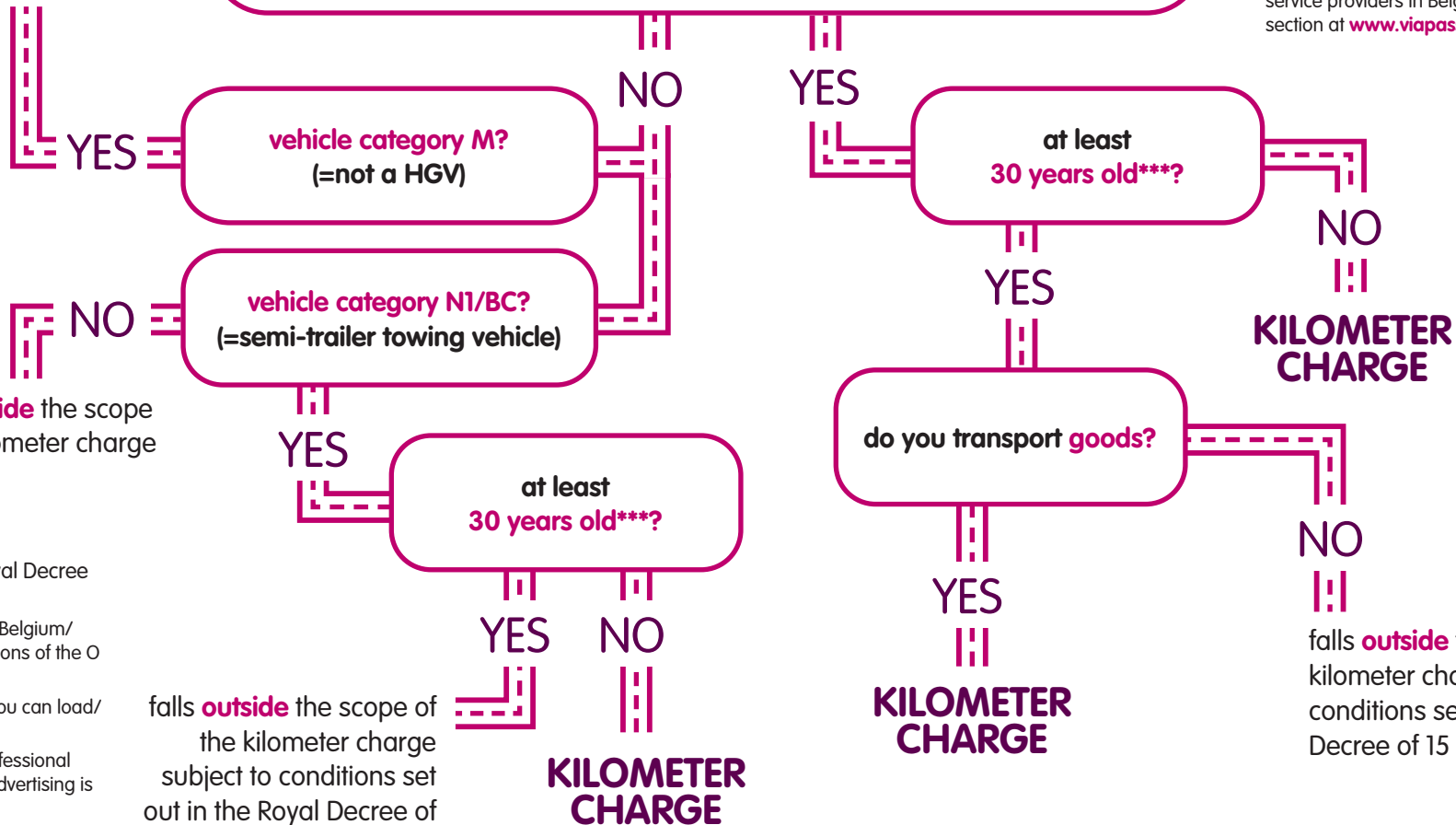
DO I HAVE TO PAY THE KILOMETER CHARGE FOR MY OLDTIMER TRUCK?

falls **outside** the scope of the kilometer charge

Vehicle (or tractor unit) > 3.5 tons GVW* registered as vehicle category N / a Heavy Goods Vehicle (HGV)?
see vehicle documents

KILOMETER CHARGE WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

- An On Board Unit (OBU) records the kilometers driven on toll roads.
- You can obtain an OBU from one of the accredited service providers in Belgium (see the "practical info" section at www.viapass.be).



**Conditions set out in the Royal Decree of 15 March 1968:

- compulsory O number plate in Belgium/ foreigners subject to the conditions of the O number plate.
- no goods transport: anything you can load/unload like another oldtimer.
- not used for commercial or professional purposes. Attention: carrying advertising is also a commercial activity.
- not used for daily travel such as commuting.

*GVW = gross vehicle weight, see registration certificate box J
*** As from 1 July 2023
